Global Network for Academic Public Health Participation in Sessions During the World Congress on Public Health May 4 & 5, 2023 Rome, Italy

Background

The Global Network for Academic Public Health (GNAPH) is organizing a series of sessions for the World Congress on Public Health, to be held May 2-6, 2023, in Rome, Italy. Two sessions have opportunities for presentations from members of the associations that make up the GNAPH. This call is for expressions of interest in giving a presentation as part of one or both of these sessions.
