Early Career Support, Networking & Paid Internships –

Annual CAPHIA Awards 😑

The awards recognise individuals or teams currently working at a CAPHIA member institution who have made an outstanding contribution to public health teaching and learning, and/or research and who have clearly demonstrated excellence and innovation.

Workshops, Summits & Resources

CAPHIA regularly hosts a variety of events for members to develop their capability and capacity. This includes targeted programs for <u>Early Career Academics</u>, a annual Heads of Schools Summit and a variety of professional development events. Regular resources and communications are also provided.

CAPHIA Competencies Renewal Project

The Third Edition of the CAPHIA competencies is being collaboratively co-designed via a 3-staged research approach to characterise the competencies [knowledge, skills, attributes] required by public health graduates to effectively contribute to the workforce and meet existing and emergent public health.

Advocacy

We advocate for public health teaching, learning, and research particularly for and with Indigenous and culturally and linguistically diverse people, to improve the health of Australasian people and their health systems.



Calls to Action, Submissions, Position Statements and Publications

The CAPHIA community develops a range of materials to build the evidence and advocate for the advancement of public health education, research and workforce development. CAPHIA also participates in consultations and writes articles in peer reviewed journals. The Advocacy In Action Consultation Group lead this work and request input from the community via top-down and bottom-up mechanisms to reflect member views.

Partnerships & Networks

We work with individual organisations and consortiums to represent and advocate for Australasian academic public health.

Global engagements

CAPHIA members and representatives are active participants on a number of international organisations, governance bodies. Through these partnerships, CAPHIA members are able to receive exclusive benefits such as grant funding, involvement in WHO competency development work and global events.
